Radcliffe College Alumnae Oral History Project \$25,000 Matching Challenge

Radcliffe Club of San Francisco is delighted to announce that an anonymous alumna has pledged to match the next \$25,000 contributed (dollar-for-dollar) for the Radcliffe College Alumnae Oral History Project.

The project was founded in 2019, and the interviewers have made great progress in the past 3-1/2 years, despite the complications of interviewing during the pandemic.

As of April 2023, 105 alumnae from the Classes of 1941 through 1962 have been interviewed, and the transcripts are being contributed to the Radcliffe College Archives at the Arthur and Elizabeth Schlesinger Library on the History of Women in America, at Harvard University. Interviews are under way for alumnae from the Classes of 1963 through 1974, with 35 interviews completed so far.

Your support will help pay for more interview transcriptions and the training of additional volunteer interviewers. The average cost of preparing a transcription, including some administrative expenses, is about \$350 per interview.
